

Batteries

Your battery bank is only as strong as your weakest battery.

Fuel Filters

Fuel filters are an essential component of your boat's fuel system as they help remove impurities before the fuel reaches the engine.

Impellers

To prevent overheating, all boats have impellers that bring cool water into your engine.

Zincs are often overlooked during spring inspections but are an important component to keeping you above water.

Safety Gear

Last but certainly not least, inspecting your safety gear and replacing anything that is outdated will help keep you and your family safe. Get your vessel safety check for the cruising season.

Performing regular maintenance and having your boat serviced by you or a reputable marina, you will have peace of mind when heading out on your adventures this summer.





It has been pointed out to me that I have told some people "same time as last year", which was 1:00, and put in my notices 2:00. So, to avoid any confusion (good luck Gary) You may start arriving at 1:00 or any time you wish after that. We will plan on eating around 2:30 subject to change, but it won't be any earlier than 2:30.

Some people have told me they have other things that they are doing earlier in the day, and so they can't make it in time for our BBQ. Don't let that stop you, come after your morning activities are over, even if you have already eaten. Come and hang out with us in the afternoon. You don't have to eat to participate. Take Lacey exit 109. Turn West and drive short distance to College St. Turn left on College and drive all of the way thru town 4.7 miles. As you ly Lacey city limits you pass under a railroad bridge and road becomes known as Rainier rd. Continue East on Rainier rd 7.4 miles. As you cross Military rd (flashing yellow light), you are .2 mi. from Faircourt Ln S.E. on the right. Start slowing and signaling early as traffic moves very fast on Rainier rd, there is a white fence at the corner of Rainier and Faircourt. Turn rt on Faircourt and we are the second house on the right.

FROM ROY Y

Take Hwy 507 thru Roy and Mckenna, continuing over Nisqually River and into Yelm. At the 5th stop light turn left and head South (still on 507). Driving 5 miles into Rainier, there are 2 gas stations on the right, 2 blocks apart. Go past the Chevron station and turn right immediately after the Shell station, you can't see the street until you are right on it. In 2 blocks you will pass under a railroad trestle that is a 1 lane road so you have to take turns with oncoming traffic (be careful some people don't stop). Follow the road up the hill and around the bend, Faircourt Ln is 1.9 mi from the Shell station on the left. The street is hard to see coming from that direction so look for our neighbors white board fence and turn just BEFORE it. We are the second house on the right.


